

Call for Nominations for ANZAM Awards for 2008

Nominations are called for the following awards and will close **by Friday, 29 August 2008**.

Please note that nominations for the ANZAM Best Doctoral Dissertation Award and the Tilde University Press ANZAM Early Career Researcher Award are to be posted to the ANZAM Secretariat whereas nominations for the Pearson Education ANZAM Management Educator of the Year Award are to be posted to Pearson Education Australia (mailing details are on the forms).

ANZAM Best Doctoral Dissertation Award (sponsored by ANZAM)

The purpose of this award is to recognise exceptional doctoral dissertation research in the field of Management. The award consists of a cash prize of A\$1,000, a plaque and an opportunity to publish in the Journal of Management & Organization. The award will be presented at the ANZAM 2008 Conference in Auckland.

Tilde University Press ANZAM Early Career Researcher Award (sponsored by Tilde University Press)

The purpose of this award is to foster and recognise the search and scholarly achievements of emerging researchers who are at an early stage in an academic career. The award consists of a plaque and a cash prize of A\$2,000. The award will be presented at the ANZAM 2008 Conference in Auckland.

Pearson Education ANZAM Management Educator of the Year Award (sponsored by Pearson Education Australia)

To be presented at the ANZAM 2008 Conference in Auckland, the prize consists of a plaque and a cash prize of A\$3,000. In addition, Pearson Education Australia will provide additional sponsorship up to A\$2,500, on a reimbursement basis, for the 2008 winner to conduct a Master Class at the ANZAM 2009 Conference.
