### **Abstract:**

Constantinos gained his PhD from London's Guildhall University and is an Assistant Professor at Aristotle University where he lectures on Development Economics, Principles of Economics, Econometrics, etc. He has also taught at Britain's Open University, the University of London and Guildhall University.

He is an associate researcher at the South East European Research Centre (SEERC) where he works on social and employment conditions in South East Europe and supervises Ph.D. students.

His research mainly revolves around unemployment, capacity constraints, post Keynesian economics, macroeconomic policy, central bank independence, FDI, public spending, social cohesion, economic growth, etc. He is the editor of the International Journal of Economics and has published in Empirical Economic Letters, the Journal of Post Keynesian Economics, Economic Annals, International Journal of Economics, Review of Applied Economics etc.
